

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-40-S&S

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER TO FILE A
JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE CITY OF FOREST PARK
FOR WINTON ROAD IMPROVEMENTS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenhills wishes to cooperate with the City of Forest Park to undertake improvements to Winton Road, and

WHEREAS, the overall project limits would be from the intersection of Winton and Sharon Roads south to Ingram/Damon, and

WHEREAS, improvements to Winton Road will insure the integrity of this vital regional thoroughfare and contribute to the economic strength along this corridor, and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Greenhills, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring.

SECTION 1.

That the Village of Greenhills will participate with the City of Forest Park for improvements to Winton Road to assure uniformity of results and to complete the improvements as expeditiously and economically as possible.

SECTION 2.

That the Village of Greenhills will be the lead agency and if Ohio Public Works Commission (OWPC) funds are awarded will act as the lead contact for both the Village of Greenhills and the City of Forest Park.

SECTION 3.

The Municipal Manager of the Village of Greenhills is hereby authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement with the City of Forest Park for improvements to Winton Road.

SECTION 4.

That the Village of Greenhills will provide and/or secure the local funding for the portion of the project within the Village of Greenhills, in accordance with the final agreed to percentages as noted in the application.

SECTION 5.

That the Village of Greenhills will provide and/or secure the local funding for the portion of the project within the Village of Greenhills for costs exceeding the opinion of construction cost and outside funding as noted in the application.

SECTION 6.

That the Village of Greenhills will cooperate with the City of Forest Park in submitting the Ohio Public Works Commission Funding application for Round 26.

SECTION 7.

This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be effective immediately upon passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to begin said Winton Road improvements in a timely manner.
